Information letter – Charging problem with cNODE MiniS transponders

Transponder part number 396588 and 396590



A charging problem with cNODE MiniS transponders may occur. Under normal conditions, a continuous green light indicates a fully charged battery at 100%. The charger might continue flashing green and not show a continuous green light, and the battery will stop charging typically at 85%.

The battery capacity can be checked using a TTC30, TTC Light or via the APOS/HiPAP system.

The transponder is safe to use.

If the battery does not fully charge, Kongsberg Maritime will arrange for a battery replacement or the customer can send the cNODE MiniS to the following address for upgrade:
